Job Purpose	<p>Blackpool FC Community Trust is the official charity of Blackpool FC, based at Bloomfield Road Stadium. Working with residents as young as 2 years old up to adults in the later stages of life, BFCCT provide a diverse range of programmes to increase social inclusion opportunities; improve physical fitness, health, and education; and lessen involvement in anti-social behaviour.</p> <p>In recent years the Trust has grown significantly and has become an established organisation, providing something for everybody, that every Blackpool FC fan and resident should be involved in and very proud of.</p> <p>Blackpool FC Community trust was proud to open its independent school in September this year for Key stage 4 learners. The school is an alternative education setting to support learners who are either at risk of permanent exclusion or those who need support that cannot be provided in a mainstream setting, this includes behavioural issues, mental health and well-being concerns and students who love sport and in particular, football.</p> <p>Delivery of both GCSE and Functional Skills will be required. The post holder will work with colleagues to ensure that all learners requiring English provision are guided to the most appropriate qualification and level.</p> <p>As well as working in the school, the teacher will also be required to deliver resit GCSE English and functional skills to our college students for 3 hours per week.</p>
